Where can I get Help?

In Nanaimo, there are a number of services to help victims of crime. These are services that Snuneymuxw members can use when in need.

Call The Police

- * For emergencies immediately call: **9-1-1**
- * For non-emergencies contact the RCMP Nanaimo Detachment: **(250) 754-2345**
- * If you have been a victim of or witnessed a crime you should immediately report this to the RCMP. They will take a statement from you, make sure you are safe and charge the accused if they find enough evidence.

Contact Other Support

If for some reason you are not ready or able to go to the police, you can still contact a Vancouver Island Crisis Line, Nanaimo Women's Centre, Nanaimo Family Life or Victim Services for help.
