Outdoor Adventure Jobs

Guest Ranch Job(s) available: Trail Guides/ Product Manager. We offer year-round customized ranch and camp-based trips with add-on multi-sport activities at our authentic western dude ranch in BC.

Horse Pack Trips Job(s) available: Pack Trip Guides/ Wranglers/ Product Manager. Licensed guides escort travelers from May through October to any of our 25 wilderness camps located in the mountain tops and valleys.

Guide School Job(s) available: Instructors/ Product Manager. Teach wilderness horse guide skills. You must shoe and pack horses, cook on the campfire and take care of 20 horses.



Hiking Guide Job(s) available: Hike Guides/ Product Manager. There are guided multi-day alpine hiking trips and wilderness trekking tours from May to October. A good physical condition is a must.

Wildlife Viewing Job(s) available: Wildlife Viewing Guides/ Product Manager. Year round wildlife viewing from ranch or camps for 13 big game species, birds and other small animals.

Snowmobiling Job(s) available: Snowmobile Guides/ Product Manager. Conducting guided tours by snowmobile into six mountain areas where guests can access deep powder on the mountain tops from November through April.

Mountain Biking Job(s) available: Mountain Bike Guides/ Product Manager. We have mountain bike tours conducted through a range of mountain terrain from May to October.

ESL Job(s) available: ESL Teachers horse skills is an asset. Our ESL school offers English training and nature-based learning activities in Canadian culture not available anywhere else in the world.

Fishing Job(s) available: Fishing Guides/ Product Manager. Fishing trips to numerous rivers and lakes where five species of fish can be fished year round.



Backcountry Skiing Job(s) available: Ski Guides/ Product Manager. Guided backcountry skiing on un-tracked routes, out of remote mountain chalets and mountain huts.

Hay Ranch and trail ride guide needs 2 people to look after the ranch. You will be responsible for do the hay and guiding trail rides. Year round opportunity.

Organic Orchard Helpers

Organic orchard help needed between April and October. Tasks include tree pruning, gardening and participating in all aspects of farm, self-sustainable living on site.



MAINTENANCE

Carpenter

You will build log cabins with a team and will work on every other project like building, log fences, gates and maintenance ranch houses and out Buildings.

Mechanic

Operate and maintain farm machinery and equipment. Do mechanic work on trucks, cars, snowmobiles, chainsaws and heavy duty machinery

Plumber

You will take care of the general plumbing of the ranch. Repair existing - and install new water systems, sewers, irrigation etc.

Transport guests to and from lodges. Round trip from Vancouver hotels to lodges then back to Vancouver. Must know BC history and have clear driving record.

LODGE MANAGEMENT

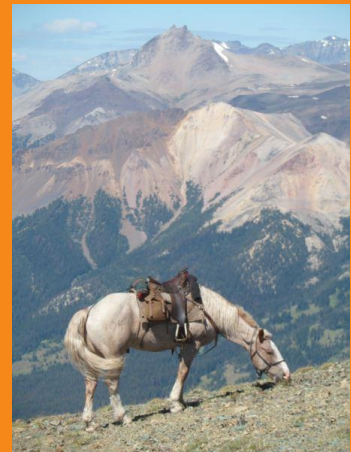
