Aboriginal Pre Cadet Training Program

It offers Aboriginal Youth the opportunity to experience daily police work with the RCMP. The summer program provides candidates with hands on experience in the RCMP's training program and unique opportunity to work in their community with police officers in the RCMP.

Develops candidates as role models in their communities and demonstrates positive alternatives to other Aboriginal Youth.

Prepares Aboriginal youth mentally and physically for training in the RCMP training academy.

Encourages Aboriginal youth to pursue careers in the RCMP.

Through the RCMP's Aboriginal Pre Cadet Training Program, the youth not only participant in training at the RCMP's Training Academy (Depot) for three weeks but they also spend the summer months assisting police officers in various aspects of regular police duties which will vary depending on the needs of the detachment and will include crime prevention and community policing initiatives.

Duration:

- 13 weeks between June and August
- 3 weeks training in RCMP DEPOT – Regina, SK (problem solving, law, public speaking, police defensive tactics & cultural awareness) followed by 10 weeks in the field

Posting:

- At any RCMP Detachment in BC between June - August

Duties:

- Aboriginal policing duties, community policing in uniform and unarmed

Salary:

- Minimum \$22.19 hour

- Be between 19-29 yrs old
- Have completed Grade 12 or equivalent
- Be Aboriginal (First Nation, Metis or Inuit)
- Be in good physical condition
- Be a Canadian Citizen
- Have a Valid Full Driver's License (No N or L)
- Be able to pass an enhanced reliability security clearance check
