In 24 weeks, students gain the necessary theoretical and practical knowledge to seek employment as an apprentice carpenter in the construction industry.

The program introduces all aspects of the trades including the use of hand tools, portable power tools, and other carpentry equipment.

Through the construction of a residential wood-frame project, students are given the opportunity to work with a variety of materials including lumber, panel products, concrete, fasteners and hardware.

Graduates of this program receive credit for Level 1 apprenticeship technical training and may also be granted practical credit by the Industry Training Authority.
