NOTICE OF POLL


Notice is hereby given to the electors of the Snuneymuxw First Nation that a poll will be held to elect one (1) Chief and five (5) Councillors for a term of four (4) years.

The poll will be held at the SFN Administration Building, 668 Centre Street, Nanaimo, BC, on Saturday, 2 December 2017, and will be open from the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. An Advance Poll will be held at the same time and place on the previous Saturday, 25 November 2017. Any elector may vote in person or by mail-in ballot.

- ◆ **An All-Candidates Forum will be held on Tuesday, November 14, between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. at the SFN Administration Building, 668 Centre Street, in Nanaimo, BC. It will be live-streamed on SFN Facebook page and posted on the website.**
- ◆ **Registered SFN members who are at least 18 years old as of the date of the election are eligible to vote.**
- ◆ Mail-in ballot packages have been mailed to electors living off-reserve who have provided the membership clerk with their current mailing addresses. On-reserve electors who will be away on both of the voting days may obtain a mail-in ballot package by contacting the Electoral Officer, providing there is sufficient time for return mail. Please inform the EO as soon as possible.
- ◆ Any elector may vote in person or by mail-in ballot.
- ◆ The term is expiring for five (5) Councillors, and one (1) Chief.
- ◆ The following Councillors will continue in their positions until 2 February 2020: Stacey Jean (Kate) Good, Regan Seward, Isaac Thomas, Doug White II, and Douglas White III.

I will begin to count the votes at the SFN Administration Building 20 minutes after the close of the poll at 8:20 p.m. on 2 December 2017, and will declare the results immediately following the count. If there is a tie vote, a public recount will be scheduled.
