1. Health Care Assistant Program – April and September 2014 \*8.5 months training, including 10 weeks of Clinical with 60 hours of Dementia Care.
2. Acute Care Certification – \*March and September 2014 \*Days/Times have not been confirmed so depending on the inquiries, we can adjust this to be offered either evenings, weekends or combination.
3. Palliative Care Certificate- \*March and November 2014 \*5 day format, Western Medicine and First Nations' perspectives
4. Mental Health Certificate- May and December 2014 \*5 day format, plus 16 hours of delivery by Canadian Mental Health Association; Western and Traditional Healing Practices
5. Biology 11 – April and September 2014 \* Its a prerequisite to Biology 12, which is a prerequisite to Anatomy and Physiology I, and course is free of charge
6. Anatomy and Physiology I & II- April 2014 and January 2015 \*Its a prerequisite to any LPN or Nursing programs; if you already have your Biology 12 and considering LPN or RN as a next step, you need to consider getting this course. Also these 2 courses give you 8.0 University Transfer Credits.
7. Pathways to Health Careers- September 2014 \*Offers Math 11, English 12, Biology 11, Biology 12, Chemistry 11, Anatomy and Physiology I & II, Introduction to Health Careers. This program is designed to allow students to obtain all the requirements for their Dogwood Diploma and acquire all the requirements to enter into Bachelor's of Science or a nursing program.
8. Licensed Practical Nursing – After January 2015 \*So if you are targeting this timeline, you need to make sure all your prerequisites are taken before the start date.
