- Ensures safety of children and report any incidents promptly
- Provides support, guidance and direction while promoting anti-bullying
- Creates activities for all youth
- Follows Youth Centre Protocols including completion of related forms
- Ensures areas are clean and safe for children

- Currently attending high school or graduated grade 12
- Experience working with children and youth, and as part of a team
- Ability to obtain a Criminal Record Check is mandatory
- Available during the weekdays and including some weekends
- Class 5 Drivers License is an asset
