TRANSFER OF HISTORICAL LANDS

Snuneymuxw First Nation and Seacliff Properties announced the formal transfer of 102 acres of land, including the ancient village site, kwula'xw, to the Snuneymuxw People as part of Recognition, Cooperation and Mutual Benefit Agreement.

This is the first step in honouring our Agreement, which will see an additional 25 acres transferred to Snuneymuxw upon the successful rezoning of the property, along with an option to purchase an additional 150 acres.

Re-building the SFN land base preserved and protected under the Snuneymuxw Treaty of 1854, honours the solemn confirmations and promises that were made over 165 years ago. Our partnership with Seacliff Properties is another step forward on the road to reconciliation with the private sector and will help our Nation fulfill our economic potential.

For the last 4 years, our elementary school, co-governed with Nanaimo Ladysmith Public Schools District, has been an example of how we can nurture the whole child and prepare them for the future.

We welcomed 120 students this year; our enrolment has grown each year since we opened. Our long-term objective is to transition QQS into a hul'q'umi'num' immersion school.
