#### **ACCEPTABLE IDENTIFICATION FOR STATUS CARD ISSUANCE**

For clients 15 years of age and under, an application for a **Certificate of Indian Status (CIS)** must be accompanied by:

### Parent/Legal Guardian:

- one piece of primary ID (from Category 1); or
- two pieces of secondary ID, one of which must have a digitized photo (from Category 2);
- if applicable, a copy of the legal guardianship order naming the guardian, if the legal guardian is applying on behalf of the child.

## **AND**

#### Child:

one piece of ID from either Category 1 or 2.

For children between 12 and 15 years old applying for a <u>renewal or replacement only</u>, please follow identification requirements for adults (First CIS must be applied by parents or guardians).
