194.7 ACRE ADDITION TO RESERVE LANDS

This October, **194.7 acres** at te'tuxwtun was returned to Snuneymuxw as addition to reserve land. This is an important step in strengthening our land base for present and future generations.

Together with the recent teytexen Village settlement, this work brings us closer to our inherent right to sovereignty and self-determination.

WHAT'S A 'QR' CODE?

LAND TOUR

On October 29th, Snuneymuxw's Petroglyph Development Group (PDG) invited members for a member-only open-house at te'tuxwtun. It was an opportunity to walk the lands, learn more about the future vision for te'tuxwtun, and connect with members of the PDG team.

We sipped hot chocolate and visited the land with our community planners. Members shared their thoughts and insights about the future of these sacred lands.

Over the past 2.5 years, we have gathered feedback from Snuneymuxw members on this ~25-acre portion of te'tuxwtun land. The proposed te'tuxwtun mixed-use development was created using that feedback.

While the vote on te'tuxwtun lands has been delayed due to the postal strike, we still encourage Snuneymuxw members to keep submitting your thoughts and feedback for this parcel of land at www.snuneymuxw.ca/cp.

YCD HISTORIC AGREEMENT

In September, Snuneymuxw First Nation signed a historic agreement with the Nanaimo Airport Commission (YCD) to strengthen economic development and support reconciliation.

The Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) recognizes Snuneymuxw's inherent rights and deep connection to the lands, air, and waters, while also affirming a long-term commitment to collaboration.

Key points of the MOU include:

- Recognition of Snuneymuxw's rights and role in regional development
- Opportunities for economic and community benefits
- Collaboration on long-term growth and planning

This agreement builds on the many important partnerships Snuneymuxw has established in recent years, further restoring the Nation's role and creating new opportunities for future generations.
