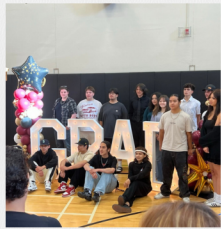
## LOOKING BACK AT 2025

In 2025, QQS saw record enrollment, with 140 students, and also expanded it's hul'q'umi'num' and land-based learning programs.



In 2025, we had 32 Snuneymuxw high school grads, and the Snuneymuxw Learning Academy (Woodbank) welcomed 22 adult learning students.



In 2025, we celebrated 16 Post-secondary grads, and supported 68 Snuneymuxw university students.



In 2025 we opened our new Snuneymuxw Youth Centre, in partnership with Kw'umut Lelum.



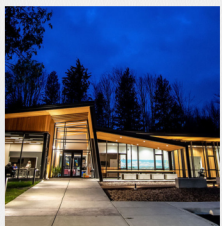
We also opened our 2nd Snuneymuxw daycare called Qwam Qwum Qeq, located near QQS, to support our growing families, balancing work, education, and raising children.



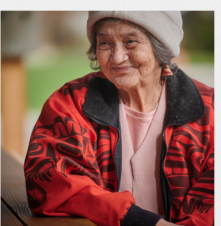
In 2025, we hired a dedicated Education Navigator, who led a series of career workshops and employer tours for our members.

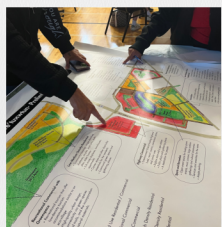

After generations of hard work, in 2025 Snuneymuxw reclaimed a total of **2,232.84 acres**

Forestry Lands:** 1976.84 acres  
**te'tuxwtun:** 198 acres  
**teytexen:** 58 acres  
**Specific Claim:** (through Land settlement)



In March, we came together as a community and voted YES on the teytexen Specific Claim Settlement Ratification Vote.



After voting YES, Snuneymuxw members received a \$10,000 teytexen distribution payment.



In October we announced that just under 200 acres at te'tuxwtun was returned to Snuneymuxw as reserve lands.



Then, Snuneymuxw members joined PDG for a guided tour of our te'tuxwtun Lands.



## PARTNERSHIP & ECONOMIC GROWTH



Our Petroglyph Development Group worked tirelessly in 2025, towards their mission to grow the Snuneymuxw economy.



This year, Snuneymuxw became a major casino operator in BC, when we acquired 2 casinos in January, and in October, we entered into definitive agreements to purchase 2 more.



In September we signed a landmark MOU with the Nanaimo Airport Commission, exploring economic opportunities, while recognizing SFN's inherent rights.



In April, we supported the Duke Point Terminal expansion launch, honouring our treaty rights and helping grow the Snuneymuxw and regional economy.



In May, we came together as a community for an audit presentation, where we celebrated 388% growth of PDG's asset base, over 7 years.



In gratitude of a great year of economic progress, we were honoured to announce a \$1,000 Christmas Distribution to each of our members.

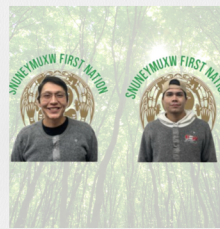
We are so grateful to our Snuneymuxw Marine Division, who helped us stay nourished, and cared for our waters in 2025!



Our Marine team worked with unwavering commitment this year, to provide multiple sockeye & prawn food fish distributions for our community, both on and off reserve.



In May, our Marine Division hosted "Marine Steward Witness Training", with 14 participants, representing 6 local Nations.



Our Lands Department continues to grow. This year we hired a new Lands Director, and 2 new Land Guardians!



In June, our Marine Division hosted another annual kw'atl'kwu event on Gabriola Island, for World Oceans Day.



In 2025, we saw Chum salmon returns surpassing 58,000 thanks to dedicated habitat restoration efforts, including: channel widening, oyster reef creation, kelp restoration, and marine data partnerships.
